Background: After a mandatory Google update earlier in 2022, the WHSLA website lost some functionality that also showed the older architecture and page structure of the website. The site relies heavily on Google Drive for file storage, which some members cannot access due to Google Drive being blocked at places of employment. Members recommended exploring migrating the WHSLA website in 2023. A small group was formed and has put together the following recommendation.
